

AFCAT Notification normally released in the Month of December to recruit the young Adventurous aspirants(Men and Women) as Commissioned Officer in Flying, Technical, and Ground Duty Branches in Indian Air Force.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Flying Branch: Should possess Graduation in any discipline or BE/B Tech with minimum 60% marks.

Technical Branch: Should possess four years degree course with minimum 60% marks.

Ground Duty Branch: Should possess Graduation Degree with 60 % marks/Graduation Degree in commerce/Post Graduation Degree/Diploma in any discipline/CA/ICWA with minimum 50% marks.

AGE LIMIT

Flying Branch: 20 – 24 years

Technical Branch: 20 – 26 years

Ground Duty Branch: 20 – 24 years

SELECTION PROCESS

Selection is purely based on the performance in below Tests conducted by Air Force Selection Boards (AFSBs). For Flying Branch candidates must appear for CPSS (Computerized Pilot Selection System), Pilot Aptitude Battery Test (PABT).

- AFCAT & Engineering Knowledge Test (EKT) (for candidates applied for technical branch only).

- Intelligence Test

- Psychological Test
- Group Test
- Medical Test and Interview
